A wide variety of small businesses exist in favelas and serve the needs of the community, but sadly the favelas are also frequently crime-ridden and have long been dominated by gangs immersed in illegal drug trafficking. Meet people from the favelas and community leaders deeply involved in improving the lives of literally millions of their inhabitants.

OLAMI MENTORSHIP TAKES ON SÃO PAULO BRAZIL!

We're excited to invite you to the Olami Mentorship trip taking place on January 31 to February 4! Please read the trip policies below.

All ground costs are covered by Olami including 4 nights at the São Paulo Higienopolis Hotel, Rua Maranhão, 371 – Higienopolis, São Paulo, transportation, food, and program activities.

Trip Eligibility:

1. By joining the mentorship program, all mentees agree to actively participate in the local mentorship chapter including at least eight one on one online or in person sessions with a mentor and two in person meetings.
2. Mentees are only eligible to join the trip upon completion of mentorship requirements and proper documentation of sessions through the online mentorship platform. Failure to complete program requirements will be considered a cancellation and your spot will be forfeited.

Participation and Cancellations:

- Mentees agree to attend the full program and participate in all elements of the trip.
- Mentees who do not arrive to the program due to a cancellation within 30 days of the trip start date or as a “no show” will be responsible to reimburse Olami for the cost of the trip valued at \$1,500.

Flight policy:

Olami is purchasing tickets exclusively for NCSY alumni up to but not exceeding a value of \$1,000. Mentees are responsible for the price difference of any tickets valued at more than \$1,000. Value of the ticket will be determined based on a direct flight to/from São Paulo expected to arrive and depart for the duration of the trip (Jan 31 - Feb 4). If mentees choose to arrive early or extend travel, mentee is responsible for the difference in ticket price to be paid directly to the travel agent.

- Beginning October 1, 2023, the Brazilian government will resume entry visa requirements for citizens of the United States and Canada. Mentees are responsible to obtain a visa for entry into Brazil as well as any costs associated with obtaining visas. Details about how to obtain a visa will be shared once available but may require a visit to the local consulate.
- Arrivals to São Paulo-Guarulhos International Airport should be timed to arrive by 11:00am on January 31, 2024. Mentees will be greeted by ground transportation to begin the trip. Mentees who are arriving to Brazil earlier should plan to meet the group at this time in the airport.
- All mentees will be required to submit their flight requests via a form provided by Olami at least 45 days before the flight. Failure to submit flight request will be considered a cancellation and your spot will be forfeited. Tickets will be booked on a first come first served basis.

Space is limited; mentees may be placed on a waiting list if trip is oversubscribed.

We look forward to a meaningful week of wisdom and mentorship.
